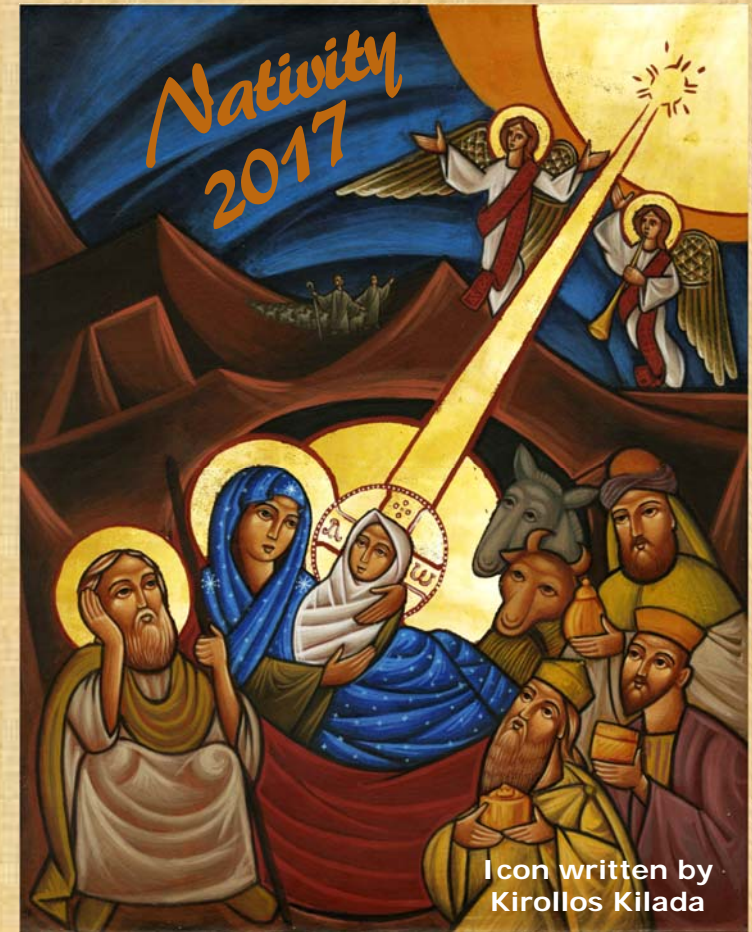

O "o" sounds like "O" (example: **Ⲑⲟⲛ** = soun [means "brother"])

Π "pi" sounds like "P" (example: **Ⲡⲉⲧⲣⲟⲥ** = Petros [means "Peter"])

P "ro" sounds like "R" (example: **Ⲡⲁⲛ** = Ran [means "name"])

C "seema" sounds like "S" (example: **Ⲫⲱⲧⲉⲉⲣ**=soteer [means "savior"])
